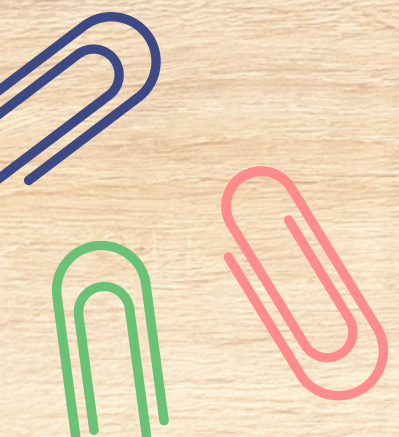
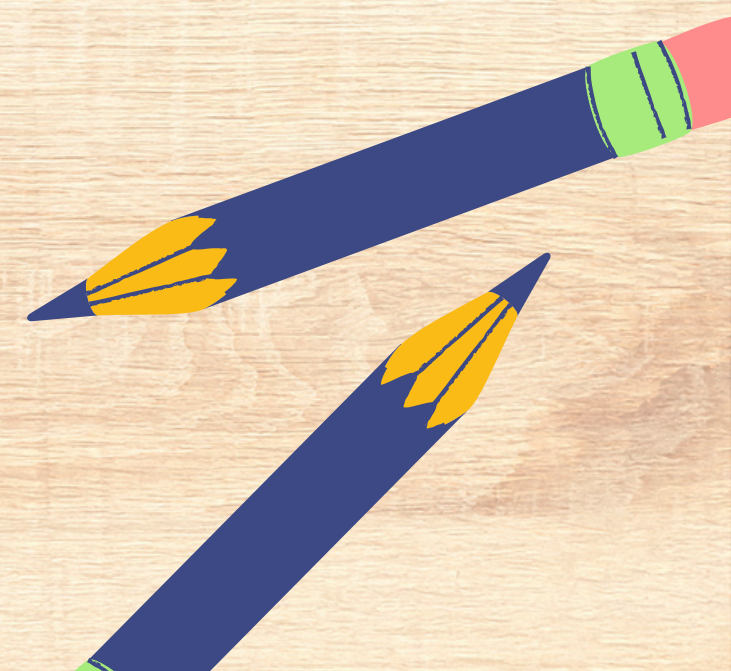


Using yeast and gelatine from pigs is not permissible in Islam. Opt for vegetarian sources or animals slaughtered in the proper Islamic way.



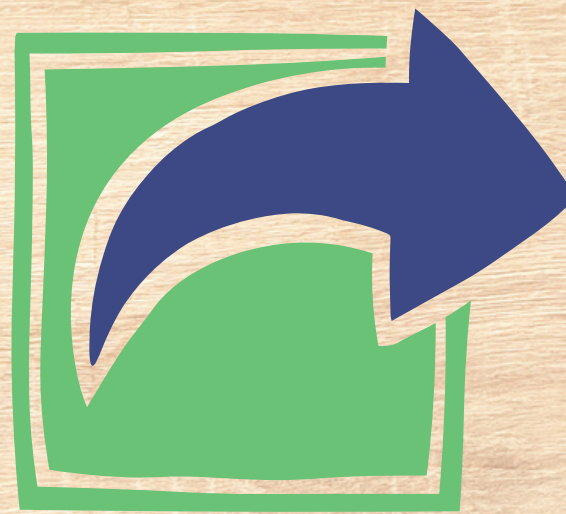

Is food mixed with traces of pork permissible? Not if contamination is certain. If doubtful, it's permissible based on original purity.

Processed foods with small amounts of forbidden products? If transformed and minimal, they are generally permissible.

Alcohol in external use products like disinfectants and ointments is permissible if non-intoxicating and medically necessary.

Navigating dietary restrictions in non-Muslim countries? Seek halal options, avoid doubtful foods, and stay informed.

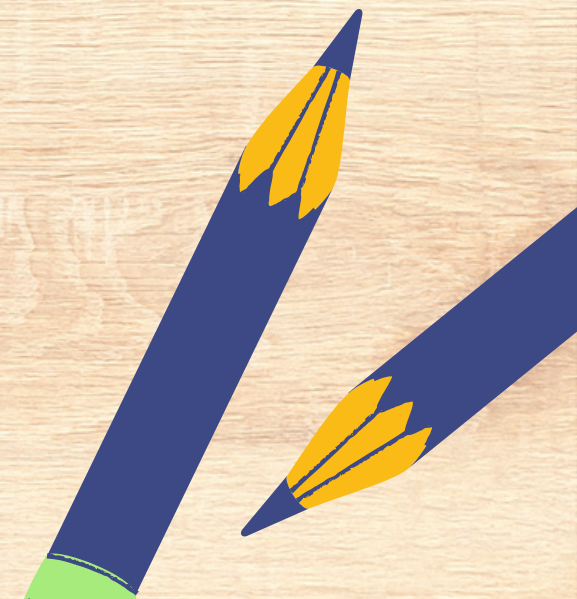




**Transformation principle:

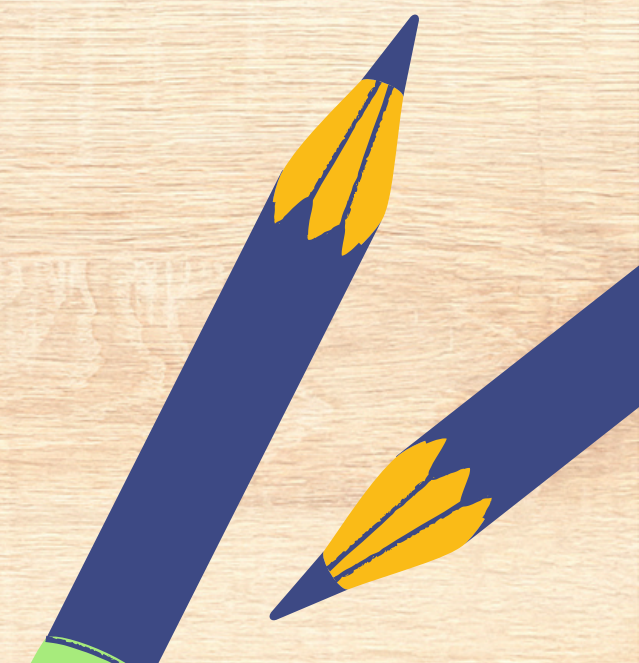


Muslims should seek alcohol-free medicines but may use those containing alcohol if necessary and prescribed.
