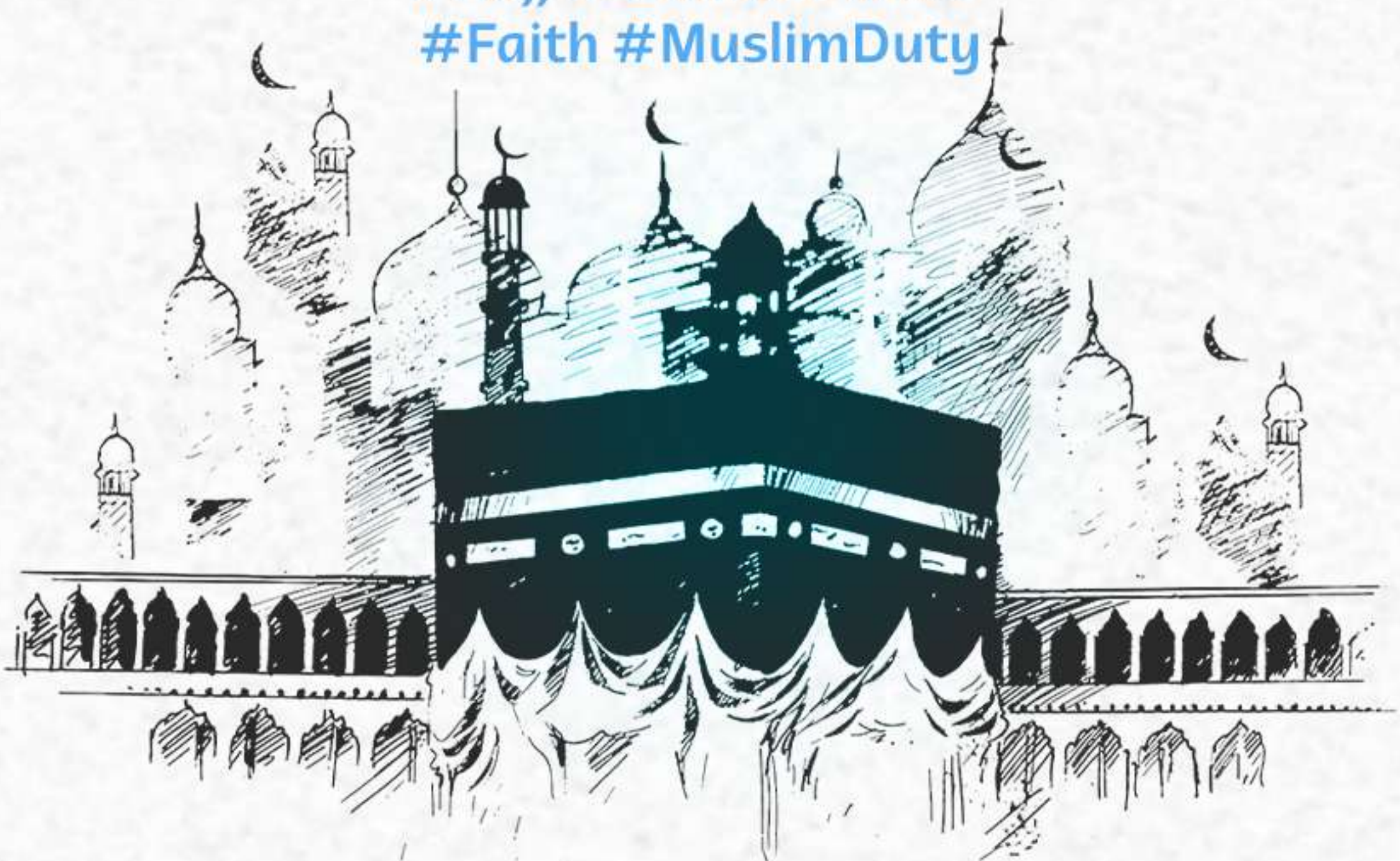

and of puberty age.

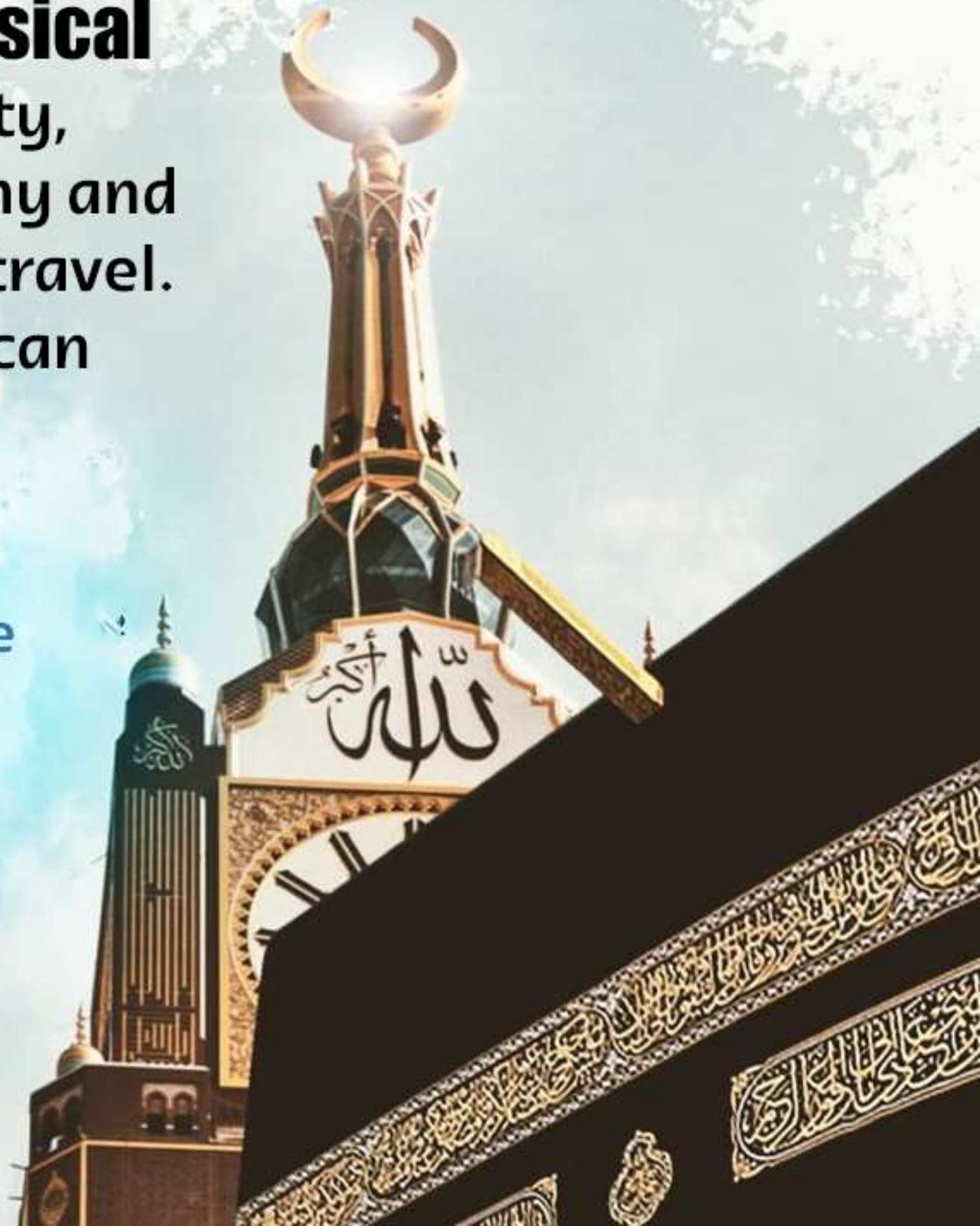
